### Available Assistance

Wood County has funding available for **Private Owner Rehabilitation** and **Home Repair** assistance. Funding amounts are determined by housing needs assessed by the Rehabilitation Specialist at time of inspection. Funding is limited, so apply soon!

### **E**LIGIBILITY

These programs are available to existing income-qualified, single-family, owner-occupied households who reside within Wood County, excluding the cities of Fostoria, and Perrysburg.

#### **PRIVATE OWNER REHABILITATION**

To bring properties up to residential rehabilitation standards: Updating Electrical • Plumbing • Septic and Well Systems • Heating • Foundations • Hot Water Heaters • Roof Repairs and Replacements • Siding • Windows • Ramps and other Accessibility Improvements

#### HOME REPAIR

For issues that pose a threat to the health/safety of the occupants: Replacement of Non-Working Furnace • Hot Water Heaters • Installation of Septic System or Well • Roof Repairs or Replacements • Water and Sewer Hook-ups • Ramps and other Accessibility Improvements • Updating Hazardous Electrical

### Terms and Conditions

#### **PRIVATE OWNER REHABILITATION**

Assistance will be in the form of declining-deferred loans. There are no monthly payments and no interest will be charged. No credit check needed. 80% of the amount borrowed will be forgiven over four years. The remaining 20% will be in the form of a deferred loan. Deferred loans do not get repaid until the homeowner sells, vacates, or transfers the title of the property.

#### **HOME REPAIR**

Homeowners receiving Home Repair assistance will receive a grant. No payment is required. (Note: Home Repair is not available in the City of Bowling Green through the Wood County CHIP. Contact City directly if interested in Home Repair, at (419) 354-6221.)
