Wood County Planning Commission Activities Report

Staff activities for August 2009 will be reviewed.

Zoning - Liberty Township

Wulff Family Farms has requested that approximately two (2) acres of land in Section 13 of Liberty Township be rezoned from an A-1 Agricultural zoning classification to an R-2 Residential zoning classification. The purpose of this request is that the applicant wishes to rent out the existing migrant worker camp in the off season. The property is located in the northeast quarter of Section 13, Liberty Township on the south side of Greensburg Pike approximately one half of a mile west of State Route 25, one half of a mile east of Rudolph Road and one mile north of Mermill Road.

Zoning – Perrysburg Township

Ofilia Rodriguez submitted an application to rezone Lots 160 & 161 in Perrysburg Heights from an R4-A Suburban Residential District (high density) zoning classification to a C-3 Highway Business zoning classification. The property is located in Section 18 of Perrysburg Township on the south side of Harold Street, approximately 170 feet east of State Route 25 (Fremont Pike), and approximately ¼ mile north of Roachton Road. The applicant indicated that an adjoining property owner has expressed interest in purchasing the property to be utilized as additional commercial parking.
